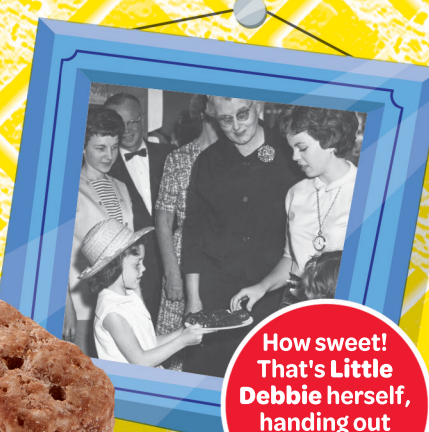


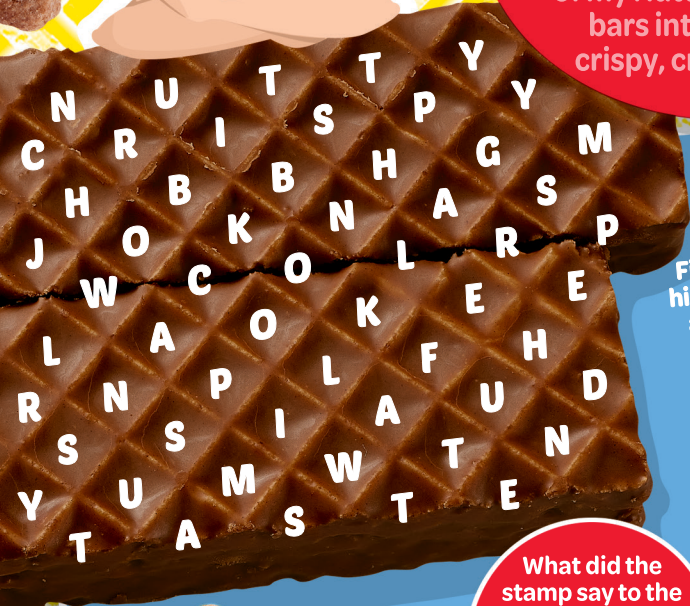


Hi!
